

Q: What if I have difficulty paying my rent?

A: It is really important to let us know as early as possible if you are having any difficulty in paying your rent. This leaflet explains some of the ways you can get help. If you have any questions please call us on **Freephone 0800 111 42 42**.

Q: Can I claim Housing Benefit?

A: If you need help paying your rent, you may be entitled to Housing Benefit which is available to help people who are on benefits or have low incomes. Housing Benefit is paid by Torfaen Council. You can get more information from the Council by calling **01495 762200**.

Sometimes, rent arrears arise because of problems with claiming and processing Housing Benefit and other entitlements. If your Housing Benefit hasn't been paid, please call Torfaen Council on **01495 762200** to find out what's happening. There could be a backlog, or the Council might need more information to deal with your claim.

Q: What if I have rent arrears?
